- 1. Why do we begin saying סליהות according to אשכנזים at least 4 days before ראש השנה? (two)
- 1) פסוק in regard to the ראש השנה on אינה says "ועשיתם עולה" so there is an element of you yourself being the קרבן so just like a קרבן needs 4 days to be checked for a מום so too we say 4 days of סליחות
- 2) There is a מנהג to fast for the עשרת ימי התשובה and off the עשרת ימי התשובה you can't fast 4 of them (ראש) you can't fast 4 of them (סליחות and off the סליחות off the סליחות instead of fasting
- 2. Why do ספרדים start saying סליחות from אלול ראש חודש?

On ראש חודש Moshe went up to ask for forgiveness for the ראש העגל and get the 2^{nd} לוחות

3. Why do we start blowing שופר from אופר?

On חטא אלול, משה went up to ask for forgiveness for the חטא העגל and get the 2^{nd} הוחות לוחות

- 4. Why don't we blow שופר on ערב ראש השנה?
- 1) To trick the שטן by taking a day off the שטן doesn't think he has to work so hard (non-literal)
- 2) To differentiate between the מנהג of blowing שופר and the מצוה of blowing שופר
- 5. Explain the נפקה מינה between the 2 Answers?

Whether you could practice: if it's because of reason 1 then no because we still want to trick the שטן, but if it's reason 2 then it's only a מנהג and you could practice at home

6. Why don't we dress our nicest on ראש השנה?

Because there is supposed to be a balance between יום טוב and trying to get forgiveness so dressing nicely is a belief all will be good but there's a little worry it all won't be good so we don't dress our nicest

7. How is the ב"ד of התרת נדרים different than a regular one?

You can have family members in it

- 8. Why can't you eat nuts on ראש השנה? (two)
- 1) You shouldn't have nuts on ראש because it creates more saliva and it'll be harder to daven
- 2) Because the גימטריה of אגוז is חט is
- 9. Why should תשליך be near a body of water?

- 1) To remind ה' of the עקידה when they walked through a river until their necks
- 2) Coronation for a king was done near the water and on ראש השנה we coronate ה' again
- 10. Why say תשליך near fish?
- 1) Fish greatly multiply, and we too want to grow in all ways
- 2) Fish are hidden under the water and they have no עין הרע so too we want to be like the fish without any עין הרע
- 11. Can you feed the fish on יו"ט? Why?

No, because it is a טרחא to feed animals that aren't yours

12. When can you sleep on ראש השנה?

We don't sleep on ראש השנה afternoon is because ראש השנה is such an important day so every moment should be meaningful and we shouldn't waste time (if you are exhausted or you aren't going to do something positive you should nap)

13. Do we blow שופר on שבת? Why?

the 100 cries of the mother of סיסרא we combat that with 100 blows

18. Why should you have a new fruit on the second night of ראש השנה?

Because we have a doubt if the second day is a new day or part of the first day, so instead of saying " "שהחיינו" on the day, we say it on the fruit and have in mind the יום
